Veterinary Services

After the evaluation of the Dane, the Dane needs to be taken to a veterinarian as soon as possible for a health evaluation. If the shelter does all the vaccines a record must be received. The Great Dane must be taken to the appropriate vet on the list of Low Cost vets. If the Great Dane needs to be taken to a personal vet approval has to be made first unless of an emergency.

Standard Vaccinations (if there is no proof of prior vaccinations):

- o Rabies
- o Parvo
- Distemper (DHLPP when combined with Parvo)
- o Bordatella

Standard Worming:

- o Hookworms
- o Roundworms
- o Tapeworms
- o Whipworms

Heartworms

• Tested: if positive look into treatments.

Spay/neuter:

- Danes of both sexes should be altered as soon as possible. If the veterinarian recommends a brief waiting period before spay/neuter because of the Dane's poor health, this advice should be used.
- NO Great Dane will be adopted out until they have been spayed/neutered. Unless it is a puppy and a follow up will be necessary to make sure the adopted Dane is spayed/neutered.
